Creative Education

Seven arguments for creative education

1. Creativity should have the highest priority at school and among the teachers.
2. Schools, which want to increase creativity, are open for contacts from outside and for new ideas.
3. Creative teachers look exactly at their students, if they have progress in learning and interest.
Teachers work together with their students, because of working out their ideas.
4. Creative teachers are highly pleased about the ability of their students, of their learning improvement and cognitions.
5. Creative teachers lead their students to self discovering learning.
They put their discoveries in various sorts of presentations, such as worksheets, posters, handouts and movies.
6. So students can show their products other groups or classes, can be proud of their products and come so in contact with each another.
So social competence and authority is increasing as well.
Some soft skills are getting normal and create a climate of confidence.
7. Teamwork becomes a matter of course.
